- All applicants that meet the requirements will be eligible for the drawing. The winner of the drawing will be randomly chosen from among applicants meeting the criteria.
- > Applicants must agree to have their name and picture published if they are awarded the scholarship.
- The scholarships may be terminated at any time by the PostCity Financial Credit Union Board of Directors.

- PostCity Financial Credit Union Employees are excluded.
