PizzaFest nominations start Monday, April 4, 2022 and the last week ends on Sunday, May 29, 2022. Only USPS departments located in the service territory served by PostCity Financial Credit Union are eligible to participate. You can cast one nomination per employee per department per week. Each week starts on Mondays at midnight and nominations for that week ends on Sunday at midnight. USPS winning departments will be different each of the 8 weeks of the PizzaFest promo. If the department garnering the most nominations during any of the weeks has already won in a previous week, the next highest USPS department vote tally will win. Each Monday, the contest starts over, and nominations begin again. Previous nominations do not roll over from week to week. PostCity will provide 10 pizzas for the department with most votes in each week. No cash value or substitutions. Pizza topping choices will be at the discretion of PostCity Financial Credit Union.
